



VP Dryland Boat Parade 2020 REGISTRATION FORM

You are invited to become a participant in the 23rd Annual Villa Park Dryland Boat Parade on Sunday, December 13, 2020. As a registered participant, you will be competing for one of several awards and have a really great time! **This completed registration form and \$20 entry fee (cash or checks made payable to VPCS FOUNDATION) must be returned to City Hall prior to 4:00 PM on Thursday, December 10, 2020.** Last minute registration will be accepted at the VPCSF “check-in-table” in front of the VP High School for \$20 on the 13th, beginning at 3:45 PM. Note that the 2020 parade entry guidelines are attached to this form and both may also be viewed / downloaded at: www.vpcsfoundation.org. All entry numbers will be assigned to participants at the “check-in table” beginning at 3:45 PM. The parade will flow through the many streets (aka: Asphalt Harbor) of Villa Park on Sunday, December 13, 2020, with the theme of “**JOY to the WORLD**”. Additional information is contained in the parade guidelines. More info may be passed along to the boat captains if it becomes available. The day-of-parade schedule is as follows:

- 3:45 P.M.** Parade entries begin to line up eastbound in an orderly fashion along Taft Avenue. All entries must confirm paid registration + acquire an entry number at the “check-in” table at this launching site.
- 5:00 P.M.** Villa Park Dryland Boat Parade leaves port for a voyage through the asphalt harbor of V.P.
- 6:30 P.M.** Parade will enter the VP Town Center by Wayne’s Liquor and continue to roll back to VPHS. Due to Covid 19 restrictions, there will be no group celebration in the Towne Center. However, everyone is encouraged to grab a bite from a local restaurant to bring more “JOY to the WORLD”!

For the purposes of this parade, a boat may be defined as “anything that can be towed or driven at a speed of up to five miles an hour.” Trees and other obstacles along the VP Dryland Parade route will necessarily limit the height of entries to 15 feet and the width to 10 feet. However, the amount of imagination and creativity used in conceiving and subsequently decorating each entry should only be limited by common sense and tastefulness. REMEMBER the theme this year is “JOY to the WORLD”.

Villa Park Dryland Boat Parade 2020 GUIDELINES

1. **PARADE STARTING TIME IS 5:00 PM GOING EASTBOUND ON TAFT AVENUE IN FRONT OF VILLA PARK HIGH SCHOOL. ROUTE MAP AVAILABLE AT: www.vpcsfoundation.org**
2. **ALL PARTICIPANTS NEED TO EXERCISE ROADWAY CAUTION AND ACT IN A SAFE MANNER AT ALL TIMES. FOR SAFETY REASONS, PARTICIPANTS MUST RIDE IN A BOAT OR "CRAFT" OF SOME KIND. ***A REMINDER...NO SKATERS OR SKATEBOARDERS CAN BE TOWED.**
3. **DO NOT THROW ITEMS SUCH AS CANDY FROM YOUR VESSEL. THROWING ITEMS FROM YOUR CRAFT MAY RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE PARADE.**
4. **BE SURE YOUR NUMBER TAGS ARE PLACED SO THAT THEY CAN BE SEEN FROM THE FRONT OR FROM BOTH SIDES OF YOUR ENTRY. THE NUMBERS ARE USED TO IDENTIFY YOUR ENTRY FOR EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY AND JUDGES TO DETERMINE AWARD WINNING VESSELS.**
5. **THE NUMBER ASSIGNED TO YOU AT "CHECK-IN" WILL INDICATE THE ORDER IN WHICH YOU ARE LINED UP. THE FIRST ARRIVAL OF REGISTERED CRAFTS... FIRST IN LINE GOING EAST ON TAFT AVENUE IN FRONT OF VPHS AND THE PARKING LOT. POSITION YOUR VESSEL AS CLOSE TO THE ENTRY AHEAD OF YOU AS SAFELY POSSIBLE.**
6. **WHILE ON THE PARADE ROUTE, PLEASE KEEP UP WITH THE ENTRY AHEAD OF YOU, WHILE ALWAYS MAINTAINING A SAFE SPEED.**
7. **PAY ATTENTION TO ANY AND ALL DIRECTIONS FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT OR CITY/ FOUNDATION STAFF SO AS TO MAINTAIN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT.**
8. **PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE PARADE STAFF UPON ENTERING THE VP TOWN CENTER AS WELL AS AT THE END OF THE PARADE AT VP HIGH SCHOOL.**
9. **ALWAYS BE AWARE OF CHILDREN IN AND NEAR YOUR VESSEL WHILE DRIVING ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE.**
10. **SET SAIL TO WIN AN AWARD IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING 2020 CATEGORIES:**
